Blooms & Butterflies – June 23, 2018

What is Blooms & Butterflies?

A one-day garden celebration in the beautiful town of Elkton, Oregon. Blooms & Butterflies celebrates the return of the butterflies to our area. The native plant garden, Butterfly Pavilion, student-run Outpost Café, and historic Fort Umpqua are all open to visitors for the remainder of the summer months.

Where is Blooms & Butterflies held?

Festivities are held at Elkton Community Education Center. We are located at 15850 Highway 38, making it the perfect spot for travelers to and from the coast to stop in, browse, relax in our gardens, and join the fun!

What events are part of Blooms & Butterflies?

The 12th annual 5K Butterfly Run kicks off the event around 9 AM. Vendor booths open at 10 AM. There will be music, food, coffee drinks and café treats available all day. Tours and historic activities will be ongoing at Fort Umpqua. Native plants, butterfly friendly perennials, vegetable and flower starts will be for sale. Educational gardening and health-oriented workshops will also take place throughout the day.

Who can participate?

Vendors who are local artists, crafters, and food growers/producers. We encourage a special focus on summer/colorful themed items at Blooms & Butterflies. We are open to school groups, local clubs, and organizations as well.

What does it cost?

Space rental is \$25 for the day, or \$40 for a double space. Standard booth size is 10 X 10 ft. Electricity is available for an extra \$10 fee (please make electricity requests ASAP so that we can make proper arrangements). Booth rental is due and payable prior to the event. There is temporary vehicle access to the booth area for unloading, set-up, and take down. There will be space allocated in the parking field for all vendor vehicles.

What is the schedule for vendors?

Set-up time is Saturday morning, June 23 starting at 7:30 AM. All booths must be ready and open by 10 AM and staffed until 4 PM. There are restrooms on the grounds and food available at the Outpost Café and the greenhouse patio for lunch. Each vendor should plan to provide their own table, chairs, and shelter as needed. Vendors should provide their own change fund. Wi-Fi is not available due to outdoor vendor set-up, please plan accordingly if using Square/other credit card reader.

Apply early and reserve your space! Applications and payment must be received by Friday, June 15 by 5 PM. Please complete the vendor application as soon as possible to secure your booth space.
