ABOUT THE JOB: ECEC is a year-round community center and a summer tourist destination. More than 4000 people from across Oregon, other states, and even outside the country come to Elkton to visit the butterfly pavilion and Fort Umpqua or to join one of our summer events. While on site, they can buy a meal or drink in the café, plants from our nursery, and fresh produce from our garden.

This summer we'll hire up to 18 high school students to help run the center. Students typically work 30 hours a week starting at minimum wage. ECEC T-shirts are provided (unisex; adult sizes). You'll work closely with skilled adult mentors and other students on your team to gain work experience and build job skills in customer service, tourism, gardening, plant & animal care, and more.
